Stock Room Strategy

2 possible approaches

- Inbound Items go in first suitable space, tell software where you put it
 - No wasted space allocated to items on loan
 - Lend Engine expects this
 - Accommodates additional stock without needing rearrangements
- Fixed placing
 - Ordered store good for users browsing
 - Efficient for regular staff
 - DO NOT use Location field in Lend Engine if you use this approach

Pricing Strategy

Seen 3 approaches so far

- Charge large up front membership fee
 - Then make loans at no cost
- Modest membership fee and rational loan fees
 - Percentage of item purchase cost per day borrowed
- Modest membership fee and Simple Loan Fees
 - Charge per loan even if returned early
 - Simple rates £1, £4 or £8 reflecting purchase cost, durability, maintenance

We went with simple

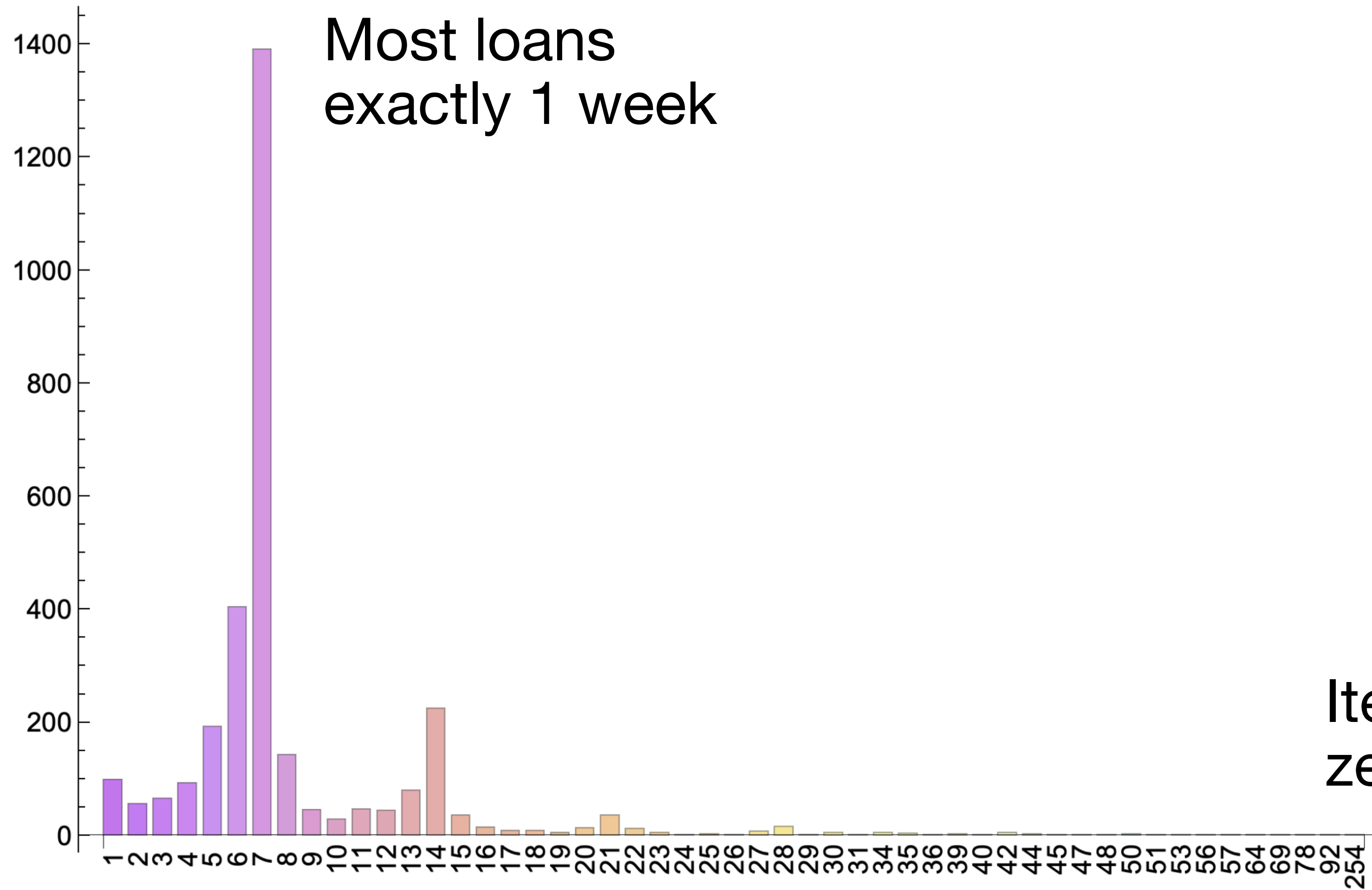
£1, £4, £8

- Benefits
 - Many users unfamiliar with concept of LOT. You will be explaining the idea over and over again. Every simplification is good
 - No need for pricing on each item for people browsing stock, mostly follows simple pattern
 - Fast and easy at the till. Till has £1, £4, £8 buttons
- Drawbacks
 - Equipment might be more efficiently used if charged per day

 - PAT Testing, Cleaning, Battery Charging, Sharpening....

- American written Asset Tracking application
 - Slick sales process, good documentation and support
- Charge for using the software **and** take a cut of your loan fees
- Only 2 images per product, but better photo quality than Lend Engine
- Inventory types fixed in advance
- Requires a user name which cannot be your email
- Check data export options
